Kevin is passionate about empowering others in the community. At the Alzheimer's Society, he worked as a design lead for Changing the Conversation about Dementia. He crafted a showcase centred on empowering individuals living with dementia and Alzheimer's disease to gain a sense of self, fulfillment and enjoyment of life.
